

Editorial Policy of Ybl Journal of Built Environment

The Ybl Journal of Built Environment aims to become a multidisciplinary forum for the presentation of original contributions, reviews and short communications in the broad field of built environment. Submitted articles should contribute to the deeper understanding of theoretical or practical engineering problems or to the improvement of engineering training.

Examples of appropriate topics include problems in architecture (green buildings and sustainability, urban planning, accessible architecture, theoretical architecture, history of architecture, design and construction of buildings, contemporary architecture, folk buildings), civil engineering (water supply, wastewater treatment, soil water, sustainable mobility, soil mechanics, building materials, geodesics, theoretical mechanics), emergency management, fire safety and construction management.

Submission of a manuscript to Ybl Journal of Built Environment is representation by the author that the manuscript has not been published or submitted simultaneously for publication elsewhere. Papers, according to the template file, should be submitted in an electronic form that does not require typesetting by the editorial office. Photos, diagrams and other inserts of appropriate resolution must be sent also separately.

Although there is no space limitation for papers, the Editorial board reserves the right to reject those manuscripts that are redundant and needlessly long.

A submitted paper will be first screened by one or two members of the editorial board in terms of novelty, quality and appropriateness and may return the manuscript immediately if it does not meet the minimum standards. Manuscripts passing the screening process will be sent out for full review. These papers will be evaluated by a minimum of two referees. Papers will be judged on the basis of their scientific content, importance, intellectual quality and readability by the possible audience.

Publishing in Ybl Journal of Built Environment is free of charge.
